

Island wide research, and evaluation surveys

Surveys on Social Issues

An Island- wide survey titled #OTW (On The Way), was conducted for UNFPA in June, 2015 to recognize the offence of sexual harassment taking place in Public Transport under the section 345 of the Penal Code of Sri Lanka. In the sampling survey, 2500 young girls and women aged between 18-35 years who travel in public transport were randomly selected from different locations (railway stations, bus halts, government and educational institutions and public places) to administer the questionnaire. The survey was conducted in both Sinhala and Tamil languages and successfully completed in July 2015.

Skills International was responsible for conducting all Island Survey using Questionnaires in 25 districts, data entry, data Interpretation and data Analysis.

Competency Standards Development (Pakistan)

A training workshop on Competency Standards Development was conducted in Islamabad under the TVET Reform Support Program of Pakistan implemented by the GIZ. The project 'Strengthening Capacity to Control the Introduction and Spread of Alien Invasive Species

'IAS Project' of which the focal point is Biodiversity Secretariat of the Ministry of Mahaweli Development and Environment was designed based on the precautionary principle by addressing the threats and root causes driving IAS in the country.




Annual Skills Report (ASR)
